### Agency-Wide Family Engagement – November 17–28

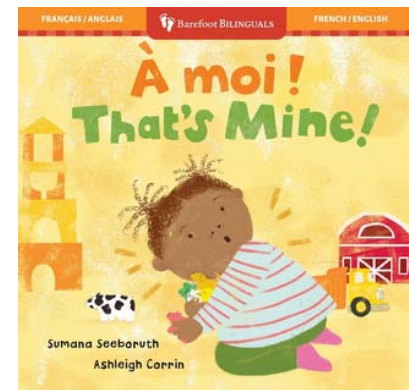
#### Mini Book Exchange
