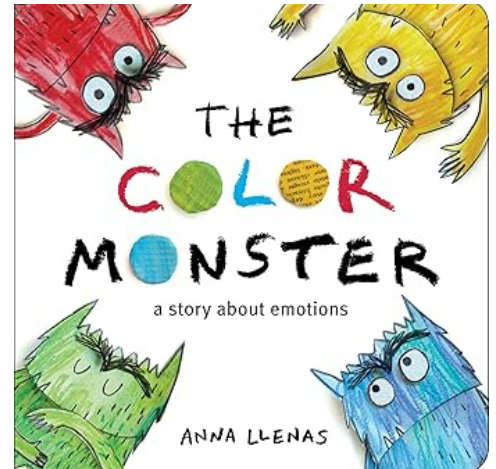

The Colour Monster is a wonderful social-emotional learning story that helps children identify and name their



emotions such as happy, sad, angry, scared, and calm in a simple and age-appropriate way. Its colourful visuals make it easier for children to talk about how they are feeling and to understand that all emotions are important and valid.
