What you need:

Baking soda, dish soap, food colouring, vinegar, snow, and a small container.

What to do:

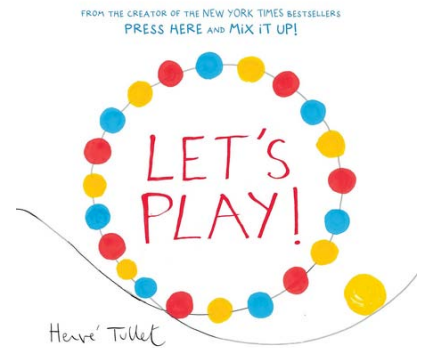
1. Add baking soda, dish soap, and a few drops of food colouring into the container.
2. Build a snow volcano around it.
3. Pour in vinegar and watch it erupt!

The fizzy reaction creates bubbly "lava" in the snow while encouraging curiosity, prediction, and hands-on exploration. A perfect mix of fresh air and science fun! ✨
