Join us at Notre Place, St-Joseph, St. Anne & MacKenzie Place during pickup time for a simple and meaningful Afternoon Tea celebration.

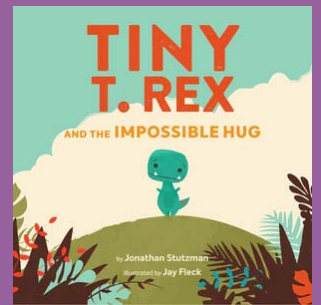

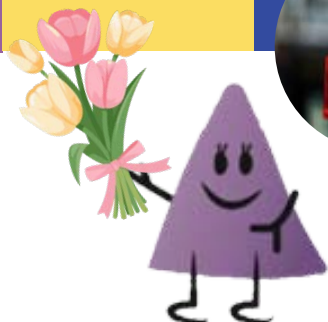
