PREPARING FOR SUMMER & GRADE 1

As Junior and Senior Kindergarten children turn 6 years old and/or prepare to enter Grade 1, they are no longer eligible for the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care (CWELCC) fee reductions, and full childcare program fees will apply for summer care and beyond.

To help ease this transition for families, Magic Triangle is piloting **2026 Weekly Summer Registrations exclusively for children aged 6–12**, offering greater flexibility for summer care planning and budgeting.

If you have not yet submitted your child's paper summer calendar, please provide it to your site supervisor immediately. Summer calendars were due on May 29 and are required to support summer programming, staffing, scheduling, and childcare space planning.
